Owensburg, Indiana

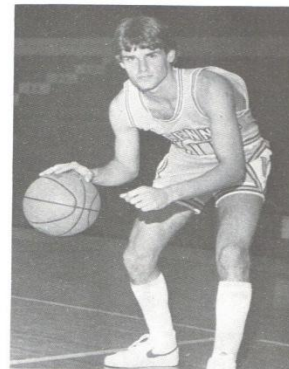

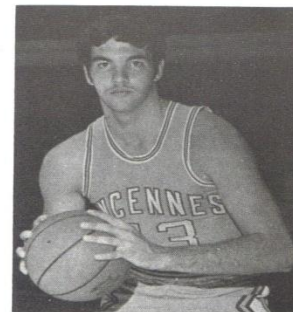

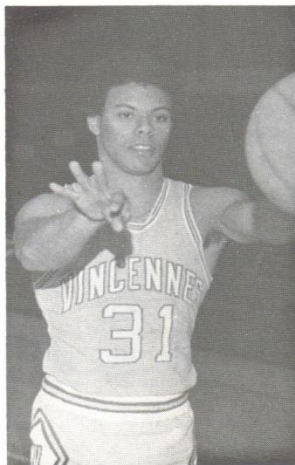


**BRUCE COPPLE**

Rushville, Indiana

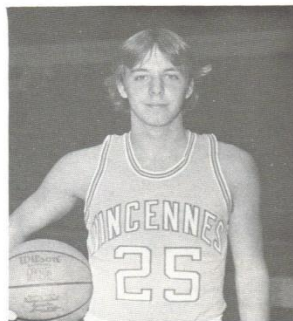

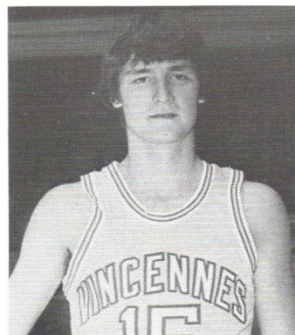

Bloomington, Indiana

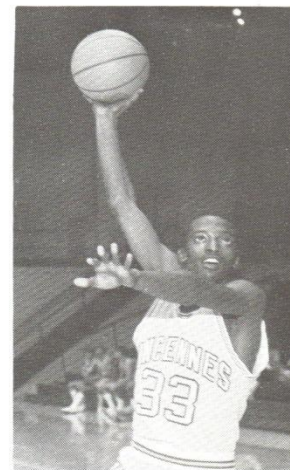

At Vincennes he is a Business major.

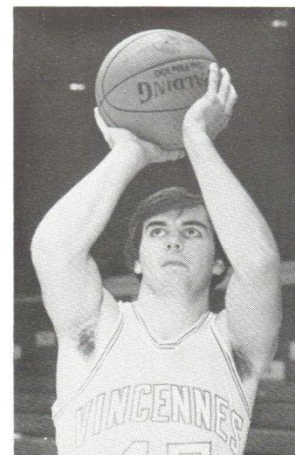


**VIRGIL KENNEDY**

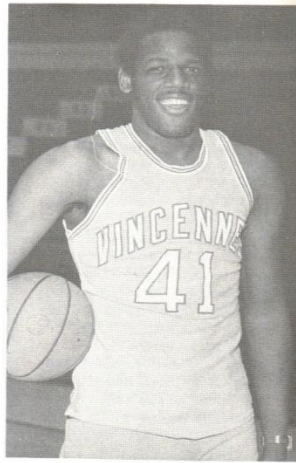
**MIKE LUTES**

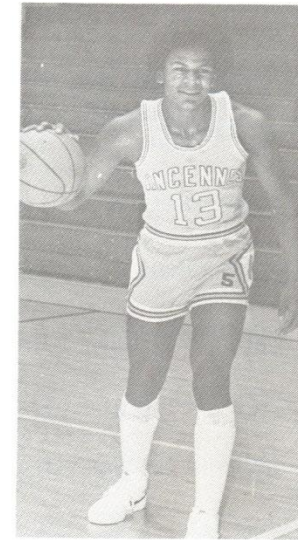

Madison, Illinois

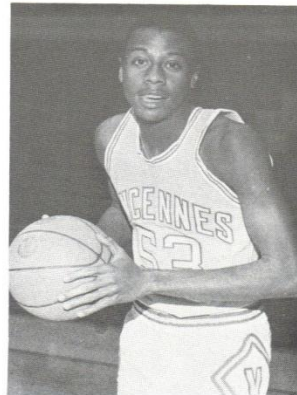

At VU he is a General Studies major.

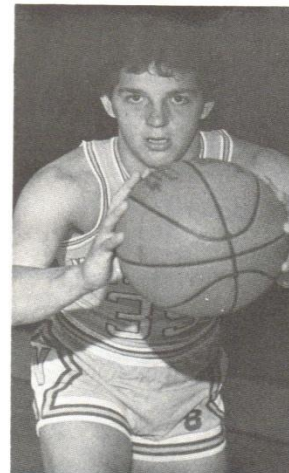


**KENT SMITH**

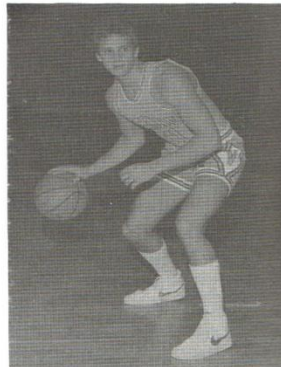

At VU he is a Business major.

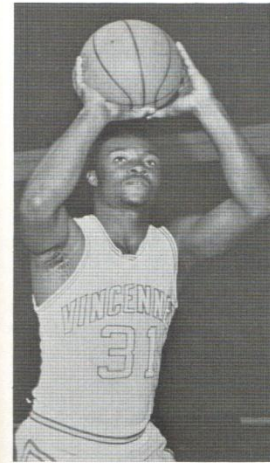

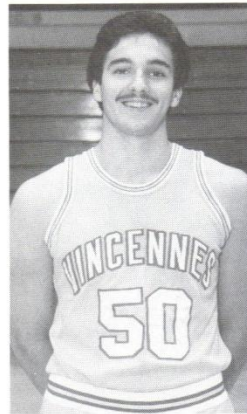
**JEROME BREWER**

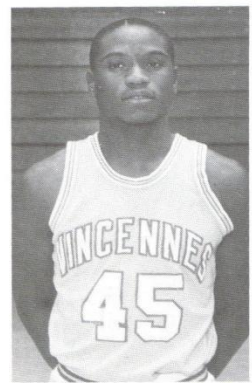


**JEFF GHER**
